

## UFO EXHIBIT AT MYRTLE BEACH

Recently, like many others over the years I and my family went on vacation to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Before leaving I was told that there was a UFO exhibit near there at a family entertainment center named "Broadway At The Beach". I visited the exhibit in a building that was close to the Margaritaville Restaurant. It was titled "Encounter: U.F.O. Experience". It is advertised as an out-of-this world family friendly exhibit based on the widespread interest in alien life. Within its seven galleries, it incorporated over 200 original and reproduction artifacts, documented film and recordings, conceptual models and interactive experiences. Replicas throughout the Exhibition were based on reports of alien encounters. On one large wall was a map of the universe. In the center of it was a small speck representing planet Earth. It really makes you stop and think. Now many of our scientists are admitting the strong possibility that there is life out there. Because of my research, I say that we are not alone.

Upon checking with the manager at the exhibit I found out that it had been there since May and will remain there throughout the tourist season. In September it will be moved to Las Vegas, Nevada. At that time they stated that 200 to 300 people a day went through the exhibit. I found that this exhibit also contained many statements by former astronauts, statesmen, military personnel, and other prominent people. They all stated on the reality of the UFO phenomenon.
