Renown psychic, Sylvia Browne, has written dozens of books on the paranormal. The one reviewed here has chapters on Stonehenge, the Bermuda Triangle, Atlantis, werewolves, the crystal skulls, and numerous other strange mysteries. Of interest here are chapters on Extraterrestrials, crop circles, the Chupacabra, creature and alien abductions.

What I found fascinating are the personal experiences Sylvia had with alleged aliens. One was in the 1970's and the other in the 1980's. In both cases the aliens were tall and human-looking and were here to "observe and help". Sylvia's beloved grandma, Ada, also had an alien encounter in Missouri.

Much of the information here is very general. Occasionally the book gives website addresses for additional information. There is no bibliography or index, however there are many illustrations.
