

SOCORRO SAUCER IN A PENTAGON PANTRY

This book is on the April 24, 1967, Socorro, New Mexico case in which patrol officer Lonnie Zamora saw an egg-shaped UFO on the ground and two small humanoids run into it after they were spotted. The craft sped away. There was physical evidence left on the ground and Dr. J. Allen Hynek investigated. Ray Stanford, the author, found a total of 13 eyewitnesses so it wasn't just one eyewitness, Zamora, as the press would have it.

Stanford accuses NASA misrepresented the evidence as just silica, when a previous scientific test had shown otherwise. There is a chapter devoted to previous egg-shaped craft seen throughout the globe. There was also a design seen on the Socorro craft, which is unusual.

Although an old book (1976), this is still worthwhile reading, because the author, Stanford, was one of the primary investigators on the scene.
