Some of the authors include, Temple University History Professor David Jacobs, the late Harvard Psychiatrist, Dr John Mack, abduction expert, Bob Hopkins, and Dr. Michael Swords.

The Hopkins article defends the use of hypnosis in recovering memories of an abduction. What I found interesting is that a scholarly University Press would publish a book of articles that is pro-UFO reality and not a skeptical debunking.
