

UFOS AND NUKES: EXTRAORDINARY ENCOUNTERS AT NUCLEAR WEAPONS SITES

There have been dozens of UFO sightings near military missile installations and at civilian nuclear power plants. Why this is, is a matter of speculation. Are aliens concerned that we may destroy our planet? That's one of several theories. The fact that the government says UFOs are no security threat is contradicted by the number of cases of UFOs affecting the missile sites with power outages.

Of the dozens of cases covered, one I found particularly interesting is an incident that took place during the Cuban Missile Crisis of October 1962, a period when the world came very close to a nuclear confrontation. I also found interesting that there have been several UFO sightings at Rendlesham Forest other than the most famous one in December 1980. It has been rumored that alleged nuclear weapons stored there were affected by UFOs.

There are also several UFOs seen over nuclear bases in Russia incidents. Of course these cases are only the tip of the iceberg, most cases probably go unreported because the eyewitnesses are afraid of government prosecution. The author states, however, that no former military officials have ever been prosecuted for telling a ufologist of these sightings.

The big question is why are UFOs seen so often over nuclear weapons bases? Is this a hint for mankind to change its warlike ways? One can only speculate.
